

COVID-19 CHANGES



Vincent Street Kitchen + Bar continues to trade as normal, albeit with a few changes.

Since the COVID-19 health warnings were announced, the Club has implemented several measures to ensure that the Club is clean and sanitised. The Club has also been proactive in facilitating 1.5m social distancing throughout the venue.

The safety and wellbeing of our Members and Staff is our highest priority. Accordingly, Vincent Street Kitchen + Bar has implemented the following changes to ensure that social distancing within our venue is achievable.

CHANGES IN OPERATIONS...

- **Non-Essential Indoor Gatherings** are restricted to no more than 50 people per area/zone, however this is expected to have little or no impact on the Club's operations
- **Trading Hours** have been reduced, closing on Sundays, Monday and Tuesdays
- Select **Gaming Machines** have been switched off to provide an adequate buffer for social distancing

The Club will continue to monitor the COVID-19 developments and review its operations to ensure that recommended social distancing and hygiene practices can be maintained throughout the venue.
